BLIND CONTOUR DRAWING

Directions:

- 1. Look around your yard or a nearby park or even in your house for a natural object. Make sure it is something that you can hold in your hand.
- 2. Hold the object in one hand and look closely at it.
- 3. Without taking your eyes off the object, draw the outline of it in the box above. Yep, you can't look at what you are drawing—keep your eyes on the object.
- 4. One more thing—you can't pick up your pencil once you put it down.
- 5. Begin by tracing the edge or contour of the object with your eyes. As your eyes move along the edge of the object, your hand draws that same shape.
- 6. When you are done, take a look at your drawing. Can you see the shape of the object in what you drew?
- 7. For an extra challenge, you can poke your pencil through a paper plate to make sure you don't look at what your hand is drawing. Try this several times with different objects. It gets easier with practice!
