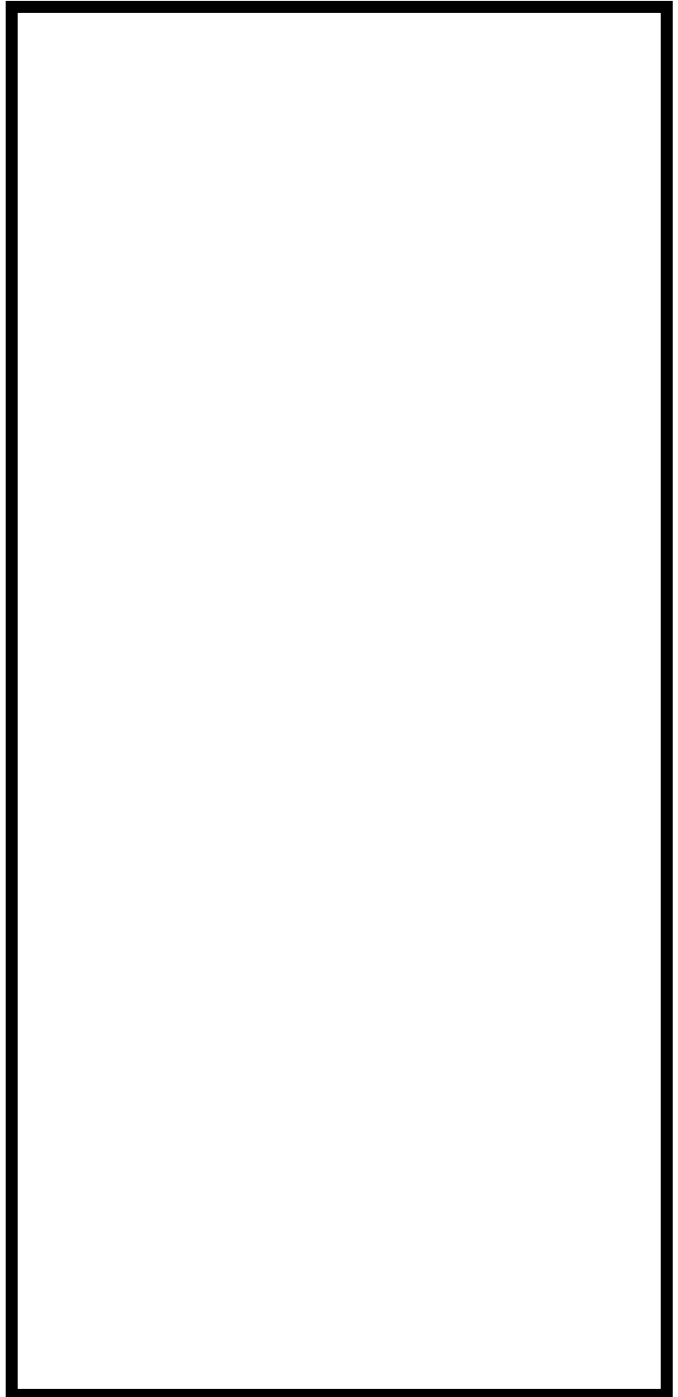


BARK RUBBINGS



Directions:

1. Examine the bark of different trees or even pieces of firewood you may have at home. See if you can find trees with different textured bark.
2. Take a bark rubbing by placing this sheet of paper over the bark of the tree. Peel the wrapper off a crayon and using the side, not the end, of the crayon, rub the crayon up and down in one of the boxes above. You will see the pattern of the bark appear.
3. Find another tree with a different type of bark and repeat in the other box. Compare the two.
