

# LEAF RUBBINGS



Directions:

1. Examine the leaves of different trees. See if you can find trees with different types of leaves (shapes, sizes, color).
2. Take a leaf rubbing by placing a leaf on something solid like a clipboard or a book. Place this sheet of paper on top of the leaf. Peel the wrapper off a crayon and using the side, not the end, of the crayon, rub the crayon over the leaf in one of the boxes above. You will see the pattern of the leaf appear.
3. Find another tree with a different type of leaf and repeat in the other box. Compare the two.
